Jurena Munoz is a Berlin-based artist with Peruvian-Chilean roots. Shamanism, rites, myths and dances as a connection between humans, the spirit world and nature are integral to her work and serve as inspiration for her masks, canvases and many murals.

Deeply impressed by the creative genius of indigenous communities, Munoz implements and reflects influences of various cultures through patterns, colors and techniques to create her own unique surreal-spiritual worlds, characterized by bold forms and the colorful palette of her Latin American roots.

Born in 1990 in Hannover, Germany, and alternately raised in the Canary Islands, Latin America and Germany, Munoz studied fashion and design - at the same time Jurena Munoz is a young „Muralista“, who is known for her portrayals of strong women and bright & colorful creations all over the world. JUMU has been traveling around this globe to leave her Latin American mark on the facades of a lot of metropolises - her murals adorn walls in Mexico, Köln, Amman, Dortmund, Tirana, Hamburg, Paris, Frankfurt, München, Uganda, Regensburg, Madrid, Hildesheim und Wien.
